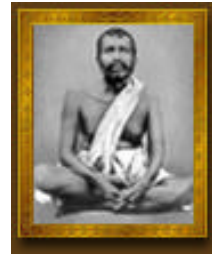

Organization's Background.....



Ramakrishna Mission Sevashram, Kankhal, Haridwar, is a Charitable Hospital. This is one of the 151st units of Ramakrishna Mission, having Head Quarters at Belur Math, West Bengal, India. This Sevashrama was established

in 1901 at the instance of great Hindu Monk Swami Vivekananda to serve the poor and downtrodden people of the Himalayan region.

Presently it is a 150 bedded multi-specialty Hospital with 3 fully equipped operation theatres, 2 fully equipped ambulances, one Mobile Medical unit, ultra-modern ICCU, Blood Bank, Doctor's Quarters, more than 100 milking cows for pure milk supply to the patients etc. It has the fully functional departments including Medical, Surgery, Orthopedic, Gynaecology-Obstetrics, Pediatric, Ophthalmology, ENT, Dentistry, Physiotherapy & Rural Medical Service.

The Sevashrama with an undaunting spirit is engaged in treating extremely poor and sick people of this mountainous and chilly region with rampant TB, anemia and other deadly diseases.

It started by treating 2500 patients (1904 record) annually. Last year it has treated 259,036 patients. This year it is expected to treat 300,000 patients. In recognition of Sevashrama being a Charitable Hospital, it is registered by the Govt. of India under Foreign Contribution Regulation Act (Reg. no. 34791000) to collect Foreign Contribution.

TB Project

T.B. is rampant in this hilly and chilly region.

- T.B. is taking one human life every minute in India
- It is estimated that about 60% of T.B. patients in India gave up their medication and failed to complete their full course of treatment due to their ignorance and poverty

This Institute started entertaining T.B. cases since its very inception in 1901 when people afflicted with this disease had no place in their own home. The Sevashrama constructed a separate T.B. block in 1911 to keep the patients in segregation and treat them. The scenario has changed now but the challenge is still staring at our face ominously.

The number of patient population is increasing 20% per year

Majority of them being utterly poor, the treatment is given free of cost, including laboratory tests which cut a substantial pie in medical expenses.

The Sevashrama over long course of time accumulated the entire infrastructure but not the required funds to grapple with the situation.



Immediate Requirement of Funds:-

1. Funds for purchasing CT Scan Machine, \$ 465,000
2. Funds for purchasing 4 dialysis units, \$ 350,000
3. Treatment and running cost of hospital for 1 year \$ 500,000
4. Development of a Corpus fund, for 100 TB patients \$400,000
5. Total requirements: **\$ 1.7 million**
